Alternate Bid for Intertie Pipeline Repairs.

The District received a request from the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside (SAM) to fund the alternate bid for the upcoming Intertie Pipeline Repairs. The base bid includes replacements of segments 1 & 3. The alternate bid adds the replacement of segment 2. SAM is requesting funding from all member agencies for the variance between lowest total bid and the construction budget of \$685,550. MWSD's share of the cost amounts to \$161,790.

The 2017/18 MWSD budgeted operations and capital needs exceed the anticipated income by \$1.48 million. This amount will be transferred from the District's capital reserve. The latest unaudited financial report shows the District's sewer capital reserve funds at \$3.8 million.

The additionally requested \$161,790 will increase the transfer from reserves from \$1.48 to \$1.64 million.

RESOLUTION OF THE MONTARA WATER AND SANITARY DISTRICT APPROVING FUNDING REQUEST FOR ALTERNATE BID OF FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Montara Water and Sanitary District adopted Resolution No. 1622, Resolution of the Montara Water and Sanitary District Consenting to Approval by Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside of its General Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Portion of said Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside Budget anticipates spending One Million Three Hundred and Eleven Thousand and Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,311,500) for the Force Main Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside approved the lowest responsible bid for the project, including the alternate bid, for the total amount of One Million Nine Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand and Fifty Dollars (\$1,997,050); and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside is requesting the member agencies to authorize an additional Six Hundred and Eighty Five Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$685,550) to finance the entire project; and

WHEREAS, Montara Water and Sanitary District's share of the request has been determined to be One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$161,790);

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Montara Water and Sanitary District, a public agency in the County of San Mateo, California as follows:

- 1. Consent is hereby given to the approval by Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside for the lowest responsible bid including alternate bid for the Force Main Replacement Project.
- 2. The General Manager is authorized to pay an additional One Hundred and One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$161,790) from the District's Capital Reserve to the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside for the Force Main Replacement Project.
- **3.** The District Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside, the Granada Community Services District, and the City of Half Moon Bay.

All,

At last night's SAM meeting, the Board voted to authorize a contract with Bay Pacific Pipelines for both the base bid (segments 1 & 3) and the alternate bid (segment 2). This is option 2 detailed in the attached staff report. The decision was made to take advantage of the difference of the total project cost as well as save the future cost of construction increases and deployment costs.

In order to do this, SAM will draw down the funds from its Emergency Project Reserve to get the project started. In addition, the member agencies will have to authorize an additional \$685,550 to fund the project above the available budget. The payments will be billed in 3 equal assessments over the next 90 days in addition to the regular assessments. The breakdown of the additional funding request is as follows.

HMB \$344,146 GCSD \$179,614 MWSD \$161,790

The Board stated that it was their intent to make sure that this request will be included on the upcoming City Council meeting agenda for October 17 and the GCSD and MWSD Board meeting agendas for October 19.

SUBJECT: Award Construction Contract to the Apparent Lowest Responsive

and Responsible Bidder for the Force Main Replacement Project

Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to recommend that the Board of Directors award a construction contract, in the amount of \$1,517,540, to K. J. Woods, the responsible bidder submitting a responsive bid with the lowest total base bid amount for the Force Main Replacement Project, Segments 1 and 3.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of awarding the base bid is \$1,517,540, which is approximately \$206,000 over the construction allocation in the maintenance project budget in the FY 2017/18 JPA General Budget (Attachment A). Staff recommends that the additional funds be drawn from the Emergency Repair Reserve, which would be replenished as part of the FY 2018/19 JPA General Budget request.

Strategic Plan Compliance

The recommendation complies with the SAM Strategic Plan's Vision, "Complete and fund infrastructure master plan and make operational and maintenance changes to achieve zero sewer spills within the Coastside area it serves."

Background and Discussion/Report

As identified in the SAM 5-Year Infrastructure Plan, and as a result of the five sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) during the 2016/17 storm season, the Board approved the design for the Force Main Replacement Project and authorized staff to advertise the notice for bids. The bid documents were developed with segments 1 and 3 as the base bid and segment 2 as a bid alternate to allow for the option to fund the replacement of all three segments if the bids came in within the project budget for those segments.

The notice to bidders was posted on SAM's website and advertised in the Half Moon Bay Review and the Mercury News on September 6 and 13, 2017. There was a mandatory pre-bid meeting on Monday, September 18, 2017. Three apparent responsive bids were received and opened on September 29, 2017. The bidders and the respective bid amounts are shown in the following table.

All three of the base bids are above the approved maintenance project budget. Therefore, the Board has the following three options:

- 1. Award the base bid to K.J. Woods, the bidder who submitted the apparent lowest *total base* bid in the amount of \$1,517,540 for the construction of segments 1 and 3.
- 2. Award the base bid and alternate bid to Bay Pacific Pipelines Inc., the bidder who submitted the apparent lowest *total* bidder in the amount of \$1,997,050 for construction of segments 1, 2, and 3.
- 3. Reject all bids as they exceed the approved maintenance project budget.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board award the base bid to K. J. Woods, the bidder with the lowest total base bid, and fund the amount that is over the maintenance project budget (\$206,000) from the Emergency Repair Reserve.

Staff does not recommend including the Alternate Bid (Segment 2) in the contract award at this time because it is not favorable to the Authority in that it will disqualify SAM from

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applying for funds from the Hazard Mitigation Grant (applications due by Nov 1, 2017). Staff recommends that segments 2 and 4 be bid together as a maintenance project in FY 2018/19.

System Management Plan.

All sanitary agencies are required to file a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) with the regulatory agency, the State Department of Water Resources. Prior SSMP's for the Montara System prepared separately, but coordinated by this agency and with Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside's own SSMP.

A combination of routine annual internal audits for collection system performance, cleaning schedules, emergency response, and the recent visit from the State Water Board staff regarding the SAM IPS spills, has provided input for this SSMP revision. This updated Sewer System Management Plan documents are made available to the Board of Directors and the Public prior to this meeting for review and comment, and will be filed with the State and posted on the MWSD website.

The overall purpose for the document is to file a plan of how to manage the operations of the sewer system, define reactions to events in the system and periodically review the performance of this agency. The major changes are:

- Legal Authority references and clarifications made between the State and Regional water quality control boards
- Emergency Contact Lists for Staff and Emergency Contract Responders
- Review of Maintenance Agreement with SAM: Hot Spots Clarifications, Monthly Communications
- TAC meetings with SAM regarding: Cleaning and Emergency Overflow Response Plan
- Pump Station Operating Procedures Reporting Requirements with SAM
- Reviewed the spill history and trends with SAM and the State
- Review of NO SPILL procedures with SAM and the State
- Revised and updated Sewer Maps and Database in GIS for cleaning schedules, hotspots and pipe ages.
