General Budget, As Amended

This Board previously approved the SAM General Budget for FY 2023-24 on June 1, 2023 and thereafter transmitted to SAM its authorizing resolution therefor. However, because the City of Half Moon Bay, one of SAM's member agencies, refused to consent to the SAM General Budget as presented, the SAM Board was unable to approve the final budget because it lacked the consent of all member agencies; instead, the SAM Board, at its June 27, 2023 meeting, approved for distribution to its member agencies, an amended General Budget containing following components:

The FY 23/24 SAM General Budget comprised of 1) Administration complete (i.e., no change from original 23/24 budget), 2) Treatment complete (i.e., no change from original 23/24 budget), 3) Environmental complete (i.e., no change from original 23/24 budget), and 4) Infrastructure Projects totaling \$1.72M: \$0.5M for replacement of boilers at the plant, \$1M for replacement of the generator at the plant, and \$220,000 for predesign work on SAM's Montara Force Main that was previously approved by the SAM Board.

The proposed amended general budget is also subject to further amendment at mid-year review or following the decision by the Appellate Court in the pending lawsuit filed by the City of Half Moon Bay.

The only difference from the previous FY 2023-24 General Budget is that the proposed amended general budget does not contain the Montara Force Main Rehabilitation Project in the Infrastructure Division.

- **2.** Resolution No. 1766, entitled "Resolution of the Montara Water and Sanitary District Consenting to Approval by Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside of Its General Budget For Fiscal Year 2023-2024" and adopted by this Board on June 1, 2023, is hereby rescinded.
- **3**. The District Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside, the Granada Community Services District and the City of Half Moon Bay.
